VISION

Aicon Art specializes in modern and contemporary non-Western art with a special focus on South Asia. The New York gallery and the presentations in California, London, Singapore, Dubai and New Delhi provides a vital platform for Modern and Contemporary artists from South Asia as well as the Middle East, Africa and, finally, diasporic artists. The gallery allows them to realize their vision in a global and ever-shifting world. Alongside in-depth, focused solo shows, the gallery presents a program of curated group exhibitions that are international in their scope and ambition. Following recent debates in institutional curating, the program deliberately links together art produced recently with art made in the latter half of the 20th Century. Through this, the gallery hopes to produce unexpected congruencies, shed light on multiple modernisms, make complex the designation "contemporary" and signal a shift away from simple survey exhibitions. The gallery has collaborated with museums such as the Art Institute, Chicago; Guggenheim Museum, New York; Kiran Nadar Museum, New Delhi; Asian Art Museum, San Francisco; Jewish Museum, New York and the Louvre, Abu Dhabi. Exhibitions have been reviewed and the gallery has been profiled by the New York Times, Wall Street Journal, The Times of London, Art Asia Pacific, ArtForum and the Financial Times.

HISTORY IN PALO ALTO

Aicon had a physical presence in Palo Alto between 2006 and 2010 and was nurtured then by the support and enthusiasm of Bay Area collectors and institutions. Even after the year-round presence ceased, the gallery has continued to bring curated group shows to the area that emphasizes the richness and diversity of the art movements in South Asia. The 2021 edition of the show is a thanksgiving return – appropriately timed – to say thank you to all of the gallery's well–wishers and supporters who stood by the gallery during this last eighteen months. This edition showcases the work of established masters like M F Husain, F N Souza, Natvar Bhavsar, Anjolie Ela Menon and K S Kulkarni as well as the work of exciting younger talents like Saad Qureshi, Jayshree Chakravarty, Victor Ekpuk, Autumn Wallace and Suchitra Mattai. In particular, the gallery is happy to bring one of the artists, Suchitra Mattai, out during the run of the exhibition.

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










The life inside, 2021




